you have consistently achieved a score of
1-2 in all aspects of the guidance shown on
the reverse of this sheet.

Your Observer will notify the Guidance
Coordinator when you are ready for your
FINAL ASSESSMENT prior to TEST.
After passing your FINAL ASSESSMENT
you must then complete the application
form and send it to the Institute of
Advanced Motorists Headquarters.

Observers give their time on a voluntary
basis and the offer of £5 per guidance
session will help towards their petrol costs.
However when on pre-test or end of sheet
assessment, this should be offered to the
Senior Observer undertaking the
assessment.
